



Certified Internal Auditor (CIA)

Program Overview

Part 2: Practice of Internal Auditing

This course prepares students to pass part 2 of the CIA exam. Topics include Managing the Internal Audit Activity, Planning the Engagement, Performing the Engagement, Communicating Engagement Results and Monitoring Progress.



Part 3: Business Knowledge for Internal Auditing

This course prepares students to pass part 3 of the CIA exam. Topics include Business Acumen, Information Security, Information Technology, Financial Management.

Eligibility to Sit for the CIA Exam

The CIA exam and credential are administered by the IIA. The IIA publishes its eligibility requirements to earn the CIA credential on their website. It is the CIA Exam candidate's responsibility to determine whether the IIA requirements to earn a CIA credential have been met. CIA Exam review courses are not required to be eligible to sit for the exam and are solely intended to help a student prepare for the exam through supplemental review material.
